



## Pas de Deux Dance Studio Guidelines

2021 - 2022 Dance Season

1. The Studio's primary mode of communication is email so please keep us up to date on any changes to your email account via your parent portal.
2. **First class of the evening:** The studio **will not** be open until 15 minutes before classes start. Because the studio is rented by many groups, if the studio is unlocked earlier, do not enter until this time and make sure that Miss Zachari is there before leaving your dancer.
3. **Last class of the evening:** Please be prompt in picking up your dancer. The studio cannot close until all dancers have left (regardless of age).
4. Once paid, there are no refunds for any tuition or other fees. A \$10 late charge will be added to all overdue fees. Payment plans are always available if set up **in advance**.
5. As with any sport, **attendance is important** for ballet. However, it is important that dancers stay home when they or a family member is ill! If an absence is unavoidable, contact the studio right away via email, and join us on Zoom if possible.
6. Please be ready to dance on time each week. Dancers must wear appropriate attire for class. Please review the uniform (including hair) for your dancer's level. Dancers not in uniform will need to change before joining class.
7. All dancers should bring a small dance bag to class, with ballet shoes, extra hair supplies (hair binders, bobbie pins, etc) and a water bottle. Ballet shoes should never be worn outside!
8. Food, gum and beverages other than water are not allowed in the studio.
9. Cell phones and the use of other electronic devices are not allowed in the classroom.
10. Due to covid-19, guests are currently not allowed to view class.
11. Baby Ballet parents are required to stay on studio grounds during class in case needed.
12. **For the safety of our dancers, smoking and alcohol are prohibited on studio grounds.**
13. All children (including non-dancing siblings) must be supervised by a parent when not in class any time they are on studio grounds (including in the parking lot). Please be respectful of the space and everyone on and around studio grounds!
14. Please stay off the trees and off the neighbors' lawns
15. When dropping off, picking up or waiting on a dancer, please park close to the curb on the correct side of the street for the direction your vehicle is facing. We need to keep the street clear so normal neighborhood traffic can get through at all times.
